ReStore is quite specific in what they will accept, so please adhere to the following lists. Thank you!

Yes Kitchen and laundry appliances

No Fridges over 10 years old, AC units over 3 years old, Dishwashers made before 2014.

Yes Quality cabinets with solid wood or plywood fronts, doors and drawers attached. Clean and complete.

No Cabinet doors and drawers without the cabinet

Yes Doors in good, clean, re-sellable condition without alterations or damage.

No Flat panel hollow core or bi-fold doors. No shower doors.

Yes All varieties of metal fasteners and hardware, door knobs, hinges, cabinet pulls and knobs.

No N/A

Yes Carpet: New, never installed, carpet 100sq ft or larger; Complete unopened boxes of prefinished wood and laminate flooring, 25sq ft or larger. Previously installed de-nailed wood flooring. Clean, unstained area rugs.

No Stained carpet, cut pieces of wood flooring. Carpet less than 100 sq ft.; Laminate and wood flooring less than 25 sq ft.

Yes Quality sellable furniture. Solid wood furniture.

No Furniture with rips, stains, smells, tears, pet hair or scratches, excessive fading or sagging. Mattresses and box springs, hide-a-beds and sleeper sofas. Older style entertainment centers (i.e. large solid oak that are only able to fit older tube televisions). Waterbeds or waterbed frames.

Yes Cookware, dishware, decor items.

No Linens, towels, draperies.

Yes Ducting, flashing, insulation and vents, fireplace inserts, furnaces and wood stoves.

No Items containing asbestos, mercury or other toxins.

- Yes** Bricks, pavers, fencing, hoses, sprinklers. Tools and lawn equipment in good working order.
- No* Broken or nonworking items. Flammable or combustible chemicals, herbicides or pesticides. Automotive parts or fluids.
- Yes** Indoor and outdoor light fixtures. New lightbulbs. Electrical supplies.
- No* No fluorescent fixtures or bulbs
- Yes** Denailed quality lumber and siding in 5 foot lengths or more. Sheet goods, 1/2 sheet or more.
- No* Lumber less than 5 ft or sheet goods less than 1/2 sheet. Lumber with fasteners or rot. Used vinyl siding.
- Yes** Liquid latex paint in original container with original label attached.
- No* Dry or solid paints. Paint not stored in original container.
- Yes** Steel, white porcelain or cast iron sinks without cracks, chips or stains. Complete, clean and undamaged low flow (1.6gpf) toilets. Bathroom fixtures and hardware. Metal bathtubs. New fiberglass tubs.
- No* Composite sinks, drop-in porcelain bathroom sinks, non-low-flow toilets, used fiberglass bathtubs.
- Yes** Roofing, shingles and tar paper.
- No* N/A
- Yes** New, never installed tile, at least 10 matching square feet. New unopened grout.
- No* Previously installed tile. Opened packages of grout
- Yes** Hand and power tools with all parts.
- No* N/A
- Yes** Vinyl or wood windows, undamaged, unfogged and in working order. Shutters in good condition. Blinds, new and in unopened boxes.
- No* Unframed glass or mirrors, aluminum framed windows. Used blinds.
