We are excited to share the deconstruction and rebuild of Imagination Station which will begin the weekend of June 16th and 17th. Many volunteers helped build the original Imagination Station and it has been enjoyed by children and their families for over 25 years. This park is truly the pride and joy of the City of Troutdale!



Volunteers are our most valuable asset! We're excited to partner with each of you to revitalize one of the most beloved parks and playgrounds in East County! Leathers & Associates along with city staff and volunteers will work together to deconstruct the original structure and rebuild a new play land.

The City has a sign-up sheet for those interested in receiving parts from the old playground. City Workers will help load deconstructed items when the volunteer who has signed up for a specific section/piece of the old structure arrives with a truck or trailer. Receiving portions of the old play structure is a "first come, first serve" basis! Advanced registration is required! Volunteers must sign up in advance for the section(s) wanted and haul them away. If interested in having a section of the old Imagination Station just let us know when you sign up as a volunteer.

Volunteers will only need sturdy shoes. Gloves are encouraged, if you have them. All tools will be provided by the construction company and the city.
